

EASTOWNE POOLS GUIDELINES

Eastowne Pools are a private recreation facility owned by Croys and maintained as a privilege for the enjoyment of residents of their properties. Use of the Eastowne Pools is in no way related to any existing rental agreements.

The Pool Attendants and Owners are the final authority on matters of safety, cleanliness and discipline. Their instructions must be followed or suspension of swimming privileges will result. All persons using the facility do so at their own risk. Croys will not be held responsible for any accident or injury.

HOURS - 12:00 Noon - 9:00 pm, weather permitting. Thunderstorms, heavy rain, temperatures below 72 degrees, or lack of attendance will result in the pools closing. The season for the pool is generally considered to run from Memorial Day Weekend to Labor Day Weekend.

ADMISSIONS

1. All individuals in the pool area must have an Eastowne Pool Pass, or be accompanied by an adult resident with a Pool Pass
2. The resident who's name is on the Eastowne Pool Pass must be present when the pass is in use – you may not use someone else's Pool Pass
3. The children's play area is intended for children from 1 through 8 years old. Children in this area must be accompanied by an adult resident with a Pool Pass.
4. Persons 13 years of age and younger must be accompanied by an adult resident, of at least 18 years of age, with a Pool Pass. Residents between the ages of 14 and 17 may not accompany individuals of less than 14 years of age.

GUESTS – Limit of 4 guests per residence. All guests must be accompanied by an adult resident of Croy properties with a valid Pool Pass. Conduct of said guest is the responsibility of sponsoring resident. Misconduct and/or failure to abide by pool guidelines by guests will result in loss of pool privileges of sponsoring resident. Private parties are not allowed.

IDENTIFICATION - All swimmers must have an Eastowne Pool Pass or be accompanied by an adult resident with a Pool Pass. Swimmers must be at least 14 years of age to receive their own Pool Pass. Pool Passes will be made available by the management for \$2.00 per pass. If your Pool Pass is lost, management must be notified immediately. An additional charge will be made for any replacement.

RULES OF CONDUCT

1. **NO SMOKING** anywhere in the pool vicinity
2. No glass containers allowed in the pool areas
3. No food or drink other than water allowed in the pool areas (Pool Attendant meals excluded)
4. No loud abusive language
5. No loitering in bathhouses
6. No running, pushing, wrestling, splashing or other horseplay permitted
7. No diving toys will be permitted in either pool area
8. No rafts, tubes, flippers, pool noodles or other pool toys will be permitted in either pool area
9. Life jackets, water wings, masks, and goggles will be allowed in the intermediate area only
10. Diving off pool sides is permitted only in the adult pool area at the green line
11. No bombing is permitted at any time in either pool area.
12. All commonly recognized and posted rules of safety, conduct and sanitation shall be observed
13. All swimmers must wear proper bathing suits (no cut-off jeans, etc.)
14. Admission to pool will be refused to anyone ill or wearing bandages.
15. All bicycles shall be parked in the prescribed area.
16. All complaints must be registered with the management in writing
17. Lounges, chairs and benches must be covered by towels when suntan oils or lotions are applied
18. The cost of any property damage will be charged to the responsible person
